

Looking Back...

Sport in Allora

The citizens of Allora and district found a large variety of sports to amuse themselves in the early days. This is the first part of a series on sport in Allora up to 1935.

Athletics were part of the entertainment of the district from the early days when foot races were held on the creek flat in front of the Dalrymple Hotel. The first recorded athletics event was the Easter Monday Sports in 1882. Although the Allora Gordon Gymnastic and Athletic Club was formed in 1905, it was the combined Friendly Societies who ran the sports on Friendly Societies' Day and Boxing Day for many years. The Hibernians conducted the St. Patrick's Day Sports, well into the 1920's.

Of interest is the private match held in Forde Street in 1901 between C. "Darkey" Williams and "Dick" Wright for £3 a side. It was won by Williams, a local saddler.

Mr. W. A. Deacon M. L. A. formally declared the 1928 basketball season for the senior and school teams open at the Allora State School. The seniors were known as the "Starlights' and played matches against Warwick teams, Clifton, Greenmount, Nobby and Leyburn. The first team to represent Allora was Misses. Leila Wright, Merle Kelly, Thelma Holmes, Tossie Holmes, Nancy Easton, Marjorie Bond, and Stella Weatherley.

Matches were played on the school court until 1931 when a new court was opened on the Recreation Ground. The seniors were divided into two grades, the "Starlights" and the "Starbeams". There are no reported matches after 1933.

Regular billiards and snooker exhibitions and tournaments were conducted by the various billiard room proprietors from the early 1900's. These included E. H. Nehlsen, A. A. Cameron, A. Riley and R. W. Brown

Before a packed house in R. W. Brown's billiard saloon in 1933, Milton Holmes defeated Gus Kaiser 164-163 in billiards and Bob Brown beat "Kewpie" White 54 to 46 at snooker.

A meeting was convened by T. Maher, John Holmes and A. J. brown in July 1923 to form a bowling club in Allora. The idea was shelved until October 1931 when John Holmes and Bill Leggatt called another meeting which was met with an enthusiastic response. Mr. W. Gilmore, lessee of the Memorial Park reserve made no objection to the newly formed club leasing part of the reserve.

The official opening of the Allora bowling green took place on the 8th December 1934. On the 21st October 1936 a meeting was called to form the Allora Ladies Bowling Club and play commenced on the 28th October 1936.

The first recorded boxing match in Allora took place in Kelley's Hall in 1894. It was between Jack Kennedy of Warwick and J. Clutterbuck of Armidale with preliminaries by local fighters.

In 1909 local boxer Tim Collins defeated the Queensland champion, Max Pardella, over 20 rounds. At the end of the match, Dr. Pain treated Collins for a broken thumb sustained during the fight. Other notable local fighters at that time were Tom Collins and Frank "Bruiser" Slatter.

In the 1920's Bill Ardron of Goomburra and Bill Dank of Spring Creek fought some memorable battles. Boxing had a revival in the 1930's when Percy Carsburg was King of the ring, while Spring Creek's Jack Enright was a handy local fighter.

Congratulations also to Jack Bannister, who competed in the Darling Downs Primary Track and Field Trials, and was selected to compete in the State Primary Athletics.


Clare took out the bronze medal in the Girls 15 Year discus, throwing a State qualifying distance into the bargain.
