



### Allora Historic Machinery on Show at Gatton

The wheels are turning and clinking already with less than four months until the Allora Heritage Weekend transforms the Allora Showgrounds into historical yesteryear, one of the nation's premier gatherings of historical machinery.

Organisers of the event, the Warwick Veteran & Vintage Vehicle Club had a taste of the event to come when they attended the 19th Historic Commercial Vehicle Association of Queensland rally at Gatton Showgrounds over the past weekend.

The HCVAQ was formed in May 1991 with the aim to promote and encourage the preservation and restoration of all types of commercial vehicles over thirty years old. At present the club has over 200 members and boasts the most diverse range of vehicles of any club in South East Queensland. We have vans and utilities, mining and quarry equipment, tractors, earthmoving equipment, trucks, prime movers and fire fighting equipment, horse drawn, steam powered, veteran, vintage, petrol and diesel engined vehicles from all over the world.

Allora based vehicle and machinery restorers Ted Woodrow, Graeme McMillan and Merv Pamenter attended the weekend, Ted and Graeme members of their organization since its beginnings, both having also displayed machinery at the inaugural HCVAQ rally in 1992. Fordson tractors were a feature vehicle the weekend rally, with 37 displays gathering from across eastern Australia. The Allora contingent contributed three Fordson tractors dating from the 1940's & 50's, while Warwick local John Overall showed six tractors from his sizable collection.

Kenworth trucks were also a feature of the rally, with 67 displays assembled.

Warwick Veteran and Vintage Vehicle Club President Ted Woodrow believes the forthcoming 2013 Allora Heritage Weekend will be "bigger than ever", while adding a cautious "weather permitting". The Internationally acclaimed event that swells Allora's population by 1000's over the Australia Day weekend was cancelled in 2011 due to weather and the wake

#### Allora's Past 100 years ago October 1912 Shocking Fatality The Pea Rifle Again

A very sad shooting accident occurred on Thursday afternoon by which a boy named Robert Charles Frederick Cox lost his life. It appears that Cox was with three other boys shooting at a target on the creek bank near St. David's Church when the trigger of a rifle held across the knee of one of the boys slipped in being cocked and Cox, who was sitting near, received the charge in his side, the bullet penetrating the abdomen.. In spite of his injuries Cox, assisted by the other boys, walked nearly all the way home. Dr. Pain was speedily in attendance but from the first held out little hope and the unfortunate boy gradually sank and died about 9 o'clock that night.
