Best Junior Handler was Zac showing Chimpy; 2nd was Halley showing Sarvo; 3rd was Shayla showing Feebee

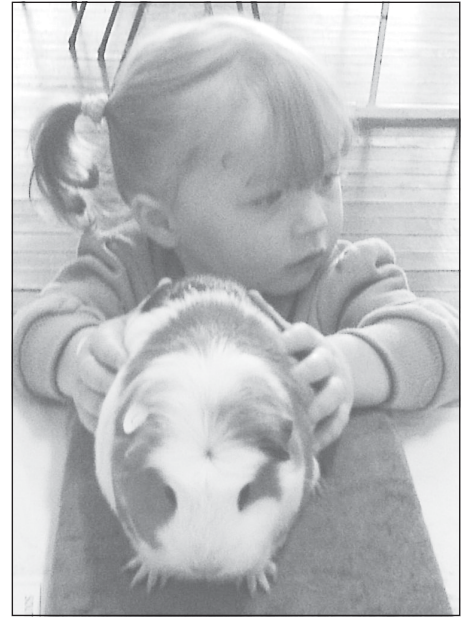

Compost in Action Workshop

Condamine Headwaters Landcare Group, in partnership with Condamine Alliance, shall host a Compost in Action workshop on Friday, 7th June at the Deuchar Massie Hall at 8.30am for a 9.00am start.

The 2 hour workshop shall be presented by Agricultural Consultant, Mr David Hall and is open to landholders, agronomists and agribusiness consultants. Discussion throughout the morning will leave participants with an improved understanding on the opportunities available to replace nutrients in the soil, lost either as a direct result of the recent flooding events or by way of crop production.

Information will focus on the benefits of compost in broad acre farming, practical methods of application, pros and cons of inorganic fertilisers, manures and composts as well as the long term effects of compost use.

Council changes saves water

The Southern Downs Regional Council will save a significant quantity of water following changes made at some of its facilities.

At the Warwick Wastewater Treatment Plant these very worthwhile changes will see recycled water put to use instead of town water.

The water savings should reach nearly 20 kilolitres each day which amounts to over 7 megalitres during the year. This equates to about 1.5 days worth of the average daily use in Warwick. The cost to make these changes will be approximately \$4,000.

"The use of recycled water at the Warwick Wastewater Treatment Plant has reduced the town water use by a huge amount," said Peter See, Director Engineering Services.

"Water charges will drop by about \$12,000 indicating a very real cost benefit from this investment of ratepayer money," Mr See said.

Council pinpoints Fire Hydrants

Residents may have noticed that some blue markers have recently sprung up on some roads. Southern Downs Regional Council has placed these markers in the middle of the road to indicate to the Fire Service the presence of a Fire Hydrant.

Council is currently working its way through Killarney and Warwick placing these markers at over 1,800 hydrants over the next few weeks. Markers have already been placed in outlying towns and villages.
