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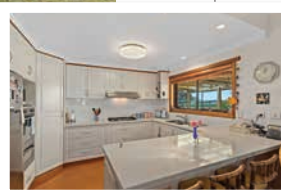
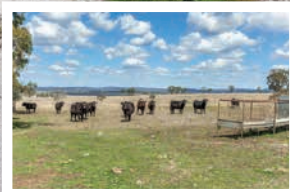
Very rarely does a property of this size and condition come on the market located so close to Toowoomba and Warwick.

She has been a true and loyal friend. Age 69 is too young to die. I am sure there was a choir of angels ready to greet her when she entered heaven.

"Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord, and may perpetual life shine upon her".

Changes Proposed For Allora Fire Station

The Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) Assistant Commissioner, South West Region, David Hermann visited Allora on Friday and checked plans for changes at the local fire station.

Assistant Commissioner Hermann met with local fire captain Ross Williams and Warwick District Inspector Hemmo de Vries.

They inspected the current premises and looked at plans to take in the adjacent S.E.S. building and use it for training/operational purposes along with the area behind the building.

It is planned to leave the fire trucks in their present location.

The size of the Allora brigade was also discussed.

At present there are only six auxiliary firefighters at Allora, when the preferred complement is ten.

It is planned to undertake another drive in an attempt

to boost the number.

During the fire chief's visit to the local region, there was also an inspection of the Swanfels fire ground, in the company of Southern Downs Mayor Vic Pennisi, to see how the fire-ravaged area is recovering after the September 2019 bushfire.

Assistant Commissioner Hermann said he visits as many stations as he can across the vast region to meet with staff so that they can put a face to the name and vice-versa, look at their facilities and find out if there is anything he can do to support them.

In the area for which he is responsible there are 38 QFES stations, 69 Rural Fire Service stations and 20 S.E.S. units stretching from the escarpment of the Great Dividing Range to Cameron's Corner.

It covers eleven local government areas and four

disaster districts.

Prior to moving to the South West Region, Assistant Commissioner Hermann had been further north and had been responsible for the

2018 evacuation of 8,500 people from Gracemere, near Rockhampton, when bushfires threatened the town, and was in Townsville when the city was hit by flooding in 2019.

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Funding For Southern Downs Steam Railway

Member for Southern Downs, James Lister has announced that his office is providing an immediate \$5,000 cash injection to help the hard working volunteers of Southern Downs Steam Railway (SDSR) keep the doors open during the challenges of Covid-19.

At the SDSR AGM Mr Lister also said "if elected, an LNP Government will provide a \$100,000 grant

to SDSR to purchase an additional steam engine for restoration.

"An extra steam engine will help SDSR to achieve extra reliability of service and better manage its maintenance. An extra engine will also help SDSR to serve new destinations and provide a better experience for visitors to Southern Downs." Mr Lister said.

Muir Street in Allora is a popular stopping point for tourists and caravaners to town. Right in the centre of Allora with toilet facilities available. However there are a few essentials missing. The Southern Downs Regional Council removed a table with seats a few months ago with the indication that there would be a replacement of two new structures but unfortunately this hasn't happened. The Allora Advertiser has been told by a local resident that Council was also to install two new benches in Muir Street but there's no sign of them yet. Footpaths are also a major concern with uneven and cracked surfaces. There's also Box Thorn growing

around a Council tree. The local resident is hoping the Southern Downs Regional Council will promptly attend to these matters in Muir Street.

Foundation Farm is an innovation hub for ag-tech that will provide a trial site for emerging technological and data-based solutions to the increasingly complex challenges facing modern farmers and agronomists, such as increasing input costs and climate variability.

Pacific Seeds Summer Grains Agronomist Trevor Philp said that this program will not only assess new technologies but will also act as a foundation for innovative research that will significantly benefit the whole community.

"We are excited about the potential benefits this project will deliver to the current farming community, but also to many future farmers as well," Mr Philp said.

"With new technologies and start-up businesses emerging every day, deciding

on the best solutions for your farm can be a confusing and challenging decision.

"Growers and agronomists need somewhere these technologies can be tested, and their value proven.

"While this hub will be used to test and demonstrate the value of new technologies and management techniques prior to implementation on farms, Pacific Seeds also identified a real demand for every day practical solutions and the need for a centre to educate young farmers and agronomists.

site, situated on the outskirts of Allora, consists of approximately 32 hectares of black clay loam soil and provides capability for both irrigated and dryland farming systems for key crops such as grain sorghum, forage sorghum and corn.

"We will begin planting the first crops within the next few weeks with plans for an official launch in early 2021.

"Our preliminary focus will be technologies specifically targeted at summer crops, with growers being able to maximise the genetic potential of their crops through the use of optimised agronomy packages. As the program expands, we intend to

diversify the target crops and even venture into livestock production systems" Mr Philp said.

Pacific Seeds has established Foundation Farm on five core pillars, comprising new technology, crop protection, crop agronomy, sustainable farming systems, and training.

"We also hope this project can bring some economic benefit to the Allora community through the research results as well as the many visitors it will bring to the town."

The exact location of the Allora farm has not been revealed as there's still development underway.

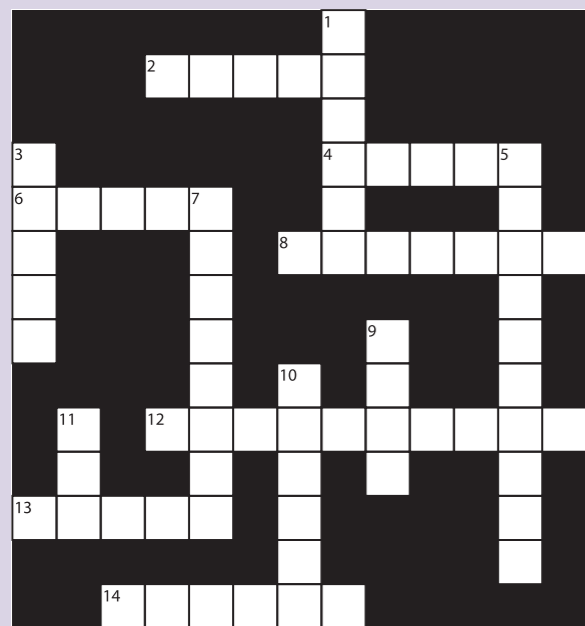

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
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Allora Night Bowls Notes
