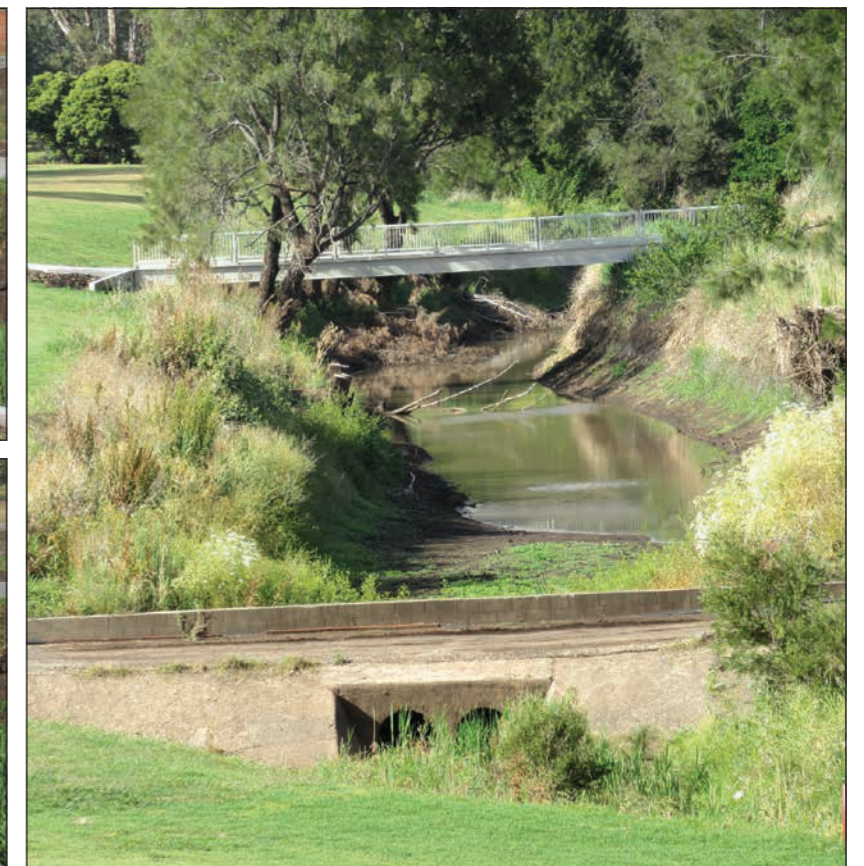

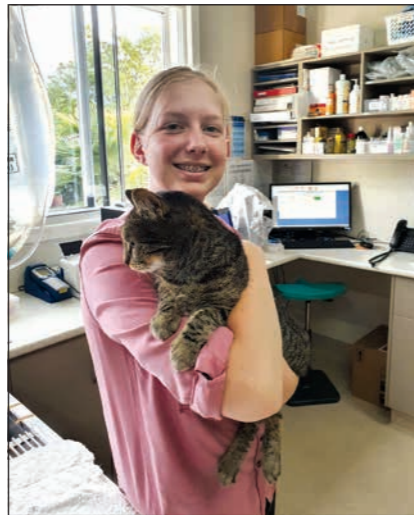

## Free Rural Water Carting

Free carting for potable water will soon be available to rural residents not connected to the reticulated water supply network after Southern Downs Regional Council endorsed guidelines for its delivery.

Under the Australian Government's Extension to the Drought Communities Programme, Council has allocated \$200,000 to cart water to rural residents, with the **cost of the water to be the responsibility of the resident.**

Southern Downs Mayor Vic Pennisi said Council had long been reviewing options to assist rural residents significantly impacted by the ongoing drought, and free water carting would offer a welcomed helping hand.

"We secured funding from the Australian Government to ease the burden with drought relief and will funnel a proportion of this into relief through free water carting.

"We expect that this program will be embraced by the rural community with the possibility of over-subscription. To ensure this funding is equitably distributed, carting will

be available through an Expression of Interest process.

"To avoid disappointment, I really encourage everyone to submit their application early and not wait until the last day or the day after the Expression of Interest has closed. Anyone with questions about the process should contact Council for more information.

"As our region is still drought declared, residents should keep in mind that there are other agencies and organisations that may be able to assist or subsidise the cost of the water."

- Applicants must apply through an Expression of Interest program.
- Cartage will be capped at one delivery for a maximum of 22,500L per property for potable water.
- Recipients cannot access reticulated water from Council's system for three months following the delivery.

Based on average water carting costs, it is envisaged that approximately 550 loads would be available through the program.

Nobby batted first and compiled 115 runs off 46 overs, John Meddleton taking 3-14, Paddy Maguire 2-27 and Albert Otten 2-24. Paddy Maguire took the first wicket for the 1995/96 season off the last ball of his first over. In reply Allora lost 2-30 before Warren Wright and Ashley Ruhle came together. Warren hit seven sixes and nine fours in his 101 retired, while Ashley hit seven sixes and six fours for his 93 in the Allora total of 321.

The day provided excellent entertainment for the large crowd and great interest was taken in the events. Competitors came from many parts of the Downs. Mr. Archie Trott, a veteran competitor, rode the winner of the open camp draft. Other winners were: George Bell on "Joybell" in the maiden draft; Hugh Byrne in the buckjumping; Tim Doyle in the open flag race, and B. Hopkins from G. Gilmore and Kevin Hardwick in the boy's, 16 and under, steer riding. Hugh Pullen and R. W. Frizzell judged the novelty horse events, school ponies and riders. Mr. W. M. Holmes is president of the Show Society, with Mr. E. J. Anderson chairman, and H. G. Deacon and C. A. Stay joint secretaries of the Sports Day committee.

Allora's Past 100 years ago October 1920

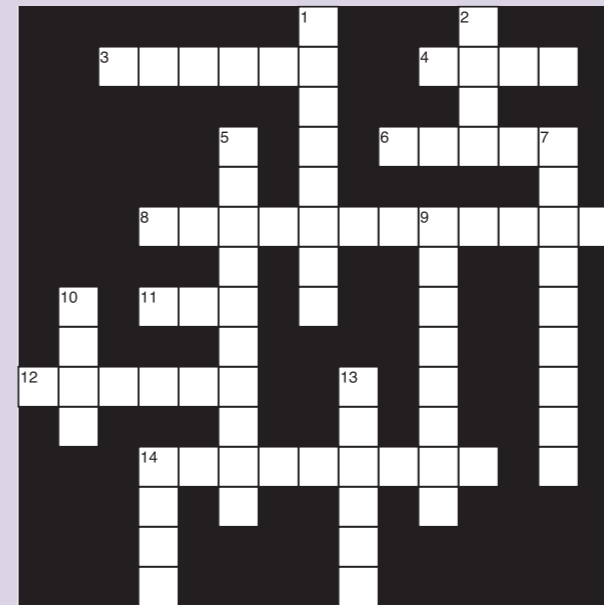
#### Hibernian Breakfast

Bro. J. Collins presided over the annual communion breakfast held under the auspices of the local branch of the H.A.C.B. Society. There was a good attendance of over 100. Visitors from brother lodges in Brisbane, Southport, Warwick and Clifton, and from local kindred friendly societies were also present. Bro. E. Fitzgerald, in proposing the toast to "The Clergy", paid tribute to the good work of Father Hennessey, parish priest. In the course of his reply Father Hennessey emphasised the necessity for farmers encouraging their families to remain in the country. City life had its glours and frivolities which appealed to vanity and self-indulgence, but would never compare with the health giving factors of the country which went to promote vigorous manhood and happier life.

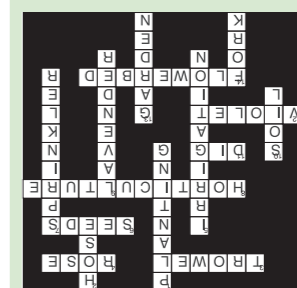
