He will appear in the Warwick Magistrates Court on February 22.







They had come to Warwick from Allora where they had been advised by police to leave that

Allora's Past 100 years ago February 1921

#### **Allora Show**

The 35th annual show of the Central Downs A. & H. Assn. opened and promised to be one of the most successful. In the stock section, entries were especially large, there being 74 entries, including 60 in the Shorthorn classes alone. Horse entries numbered 182 and poultry classes 35. Wheat exhibits doubled this year with the champion bushel of wheat entered by Arthur Masters of Hendon. In the vegetable section the most successful exhibitors were Wright Bros. of Goomburra, Mrs W. Leggatt, and H. W. Stay. In the school needlework

section most prizes were secured by Misses Masters (Hendon) and the pupils of the Clifton Convent School

# **Allora Police Court**

Michael Culhane summoned Martin Crane for assaulting him and beating him on the 26th inst. at Hendon. Not a little interest was attached to this case, as it was reported that the defendant had attempted to cut complainant's throat. Culhane, however, did not attach much importance to the affair, as he did not appear in court to prosecute, and the case was, therefore, dismissed.

(Michael Culhane was the licensee of the Railway Hotel at Hendon 1869-1871).
