It was disappointing for the Society as one major Museum would benefit Allora as well as reduce the cost of running two facilities. But never say never as the





This is a reminder that applications for round three of the Queensland Remembers Grants Program close at 5pm on

The Queensland Government has committed \$5.9 million over four years through the Queensland Remembers Grants Program to support the service and sacrifice of our veterans.

Grants are available for ex-service and other notfor-profit organisations that directly provide support to Queensland veterans and their families.

Major capital works grants program (between \$50,000 up to \$250,000 excluding GST per grant) to deliver major capital works projects, such as building refurbishments or upgrades, improving access for people with a disability or upgrading communal meeting areas.

Minor capital works grants program (up to \$50,000 excluding GST per grant) to deliver minor capital works, such as repairs to, or maintenance of, buildings or facilities or for the purchase of equipment.

Community grants program (up to \$50,000 excluding GST per grants) to deliver commemorative activities or events and projects, such as the refurbishment and creation of memorials, avenues of honour and memorial gardens. Local councils are welcome to apply for funding under the community grants program.

### Rural Aid ready to help farmers as El Nino declared



Rural Aid CEO John Warlters said the Bureau's announcement confirmed many producers' fears.

"This announcement of the El Nino weather pattern will bring a lot of unwelcome memories to the surface for our farmers, who've been anxiously watching land and waterways dry up," Mr Warlters said.

"Thousands of farmers are already managing their land with a view to drought, but this announcement makes that approach all the more important." "The past drought was

regarded as the worst in living memory for the majority of the country, and it's understandable that many farmers are scared

of going through that again," Mr Warlters said.

"We're encouraging farmers to reach out and register with Rural Aid now."

"We've already seen a huge increase in requests for emergency hay and household drinking water from farmers right across the country," Mr Warlters said.

"In the past four months, requests to Rural Aid for emergency drinking water have increased by 240 per cent, and our free water tank offer was exhausted in just four hours with more than 95 applications. We're aiming to deliver another 50 water tanks by the end of this year to meet demand."

"Rural Aid helps farmers with hay, drinking water, financial assistance, counselling and volunteers: all at no cost to our primary producers, thanks to the generosity of the Australian public and our corporate partners."

"I'm encouraging farmers who are finding themselves overwhelmed to give our rurallybased counselling team a call for a free chat, to make sure they're in the best possible position they can be to take on the upcoming seasons," Mr Warlters said.






