Disaster Support For Bushfire Victims



impacted by bushfires has been extended to cover those in the northern parts of the Southern Downs Region.

Residents who have been affected by the recent bushfires will now have access to disaster support, with further assistance activated by the Federal and State Governments.

Personal Hardship Assistance, which provides \$180 for individuals and up to \$900 for a family of five to cover the costs of essential items such as food, clothing and medicine, is now available for eligible people in the Southern Downs localities of Bony Mountain, Deuchar, Goomburra, Hendon, Karara, Leslie Dam, Massie, Montrose, Morgan Park, Mount Sturt, Passchendaele, Pikedale, Pratten, Rosehill, Rosenthal Heights, Swanfels, Thane, Toolburra, Upper Freestone, Upper Wheatvale and Willowvale.

Uninsured residents in these localities can also access income-tested

grants up to \$5,000 per household through Essential Services Safety and Reconnection Scheme to inspect and reconnect damaged services like electricity, gas and water.

The assistance is jointly funded through the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

Acting Premier Steven Miles said the fire season has already impacted many Queenslanders, their homes and businesses, with the Southern Downs area being particularly hard hit.

"I've seen first hand some of the destruction caused by these bushfires and I want to thank emergency services crews and their heroic efforts," he said.

"Extending assistance to eligible people in the impacted localities will help those who have lost so much."

Work To Commence At Warwick Saleyards

Council has awarded the construction tender to redevelop the Warwick Saleyards with the primary objective of addressing animal welfare and workplace health and safety concerns.

Co-funded by Council, with \$4.5M awarded in 2022 under the Australian Government's Black Summer Bushfire Recovery Grants Program, the \$7.5M project balances immediate infrastructure issues with a future-focused strategy whilst allowing the project to remain viable within a tight budget.

Southern Downs Mayor Vic Pennisi said works are expected to commence shortly and the necessary upgrades will secure saleyards and support the region's biggest industry.

"The Warwick Saleyards is a major economic pillar in the identity of the Southern Downs and the facility has been connecting our rural and agricultural community with stock and station agents for more than 60 years," Mayor Pennisi said

"However. the livestock industry has evolved since the saleyards started operating and there is no question that development is needed to ensure the region has quality facilities which meet current animal welfare standards and industry trends.

"The saleyards' future has been the focus of extensive



discussion and consultation with the community and industry representatives, and Council has reviewed a number of options.

"We had an extensive wish list that was unfortunately beyond our financial reach. The untimely impacts of rising building costs dictate that we need to be realistic and responsible with what is affordable, and this Council voted

to deliver upgrades within its fiscal

"We are not ruling out future stages or ideas but this is where we must start to ensure human and animal safety standards are

It is anticipated that stage 1 will be complete in March 2024 and stage 2 in May 2024.




