Dear Editor,

Halls - Simply the Facts

The Southern Downs Regional Council released a survey seeking our views on four questions - future use of the Senior Citizens' Hall, expanding the Sports Museum, knocking down the Fire Station and whether we want the Community Hall opened. The Senior Citizens' Hall future use is in the spotlight with an option to move the Library to the Senior Citizens' Hall to enable the Sports Museum to extend

Circling in our Community are rumours, stories and misinformation about a group wanting to take over the Senior Citizens' Hall that is simply not true.

The Facts are:

- There is no Petition submitted to Council about the Senior Citizens' Hall.
- 2. There is no move by a group to take over the Senior Citizens' Hall.
- There is no group seeking to take over the Library building.
- The decision on the future use of the Senior Citizens' Hall has not been made by Council - source the CEO SDRC and Mayor.
- 5. The Council has welcomed submissions &/ or presentations to Councillors in a Councillor Information Session from anyone who has thoughts on how the Senior Citizens' Hall can be used for the benefit of the community. Phone the Council and book yourself into a session.
- 6. A submission and presentation at a Councillor Information Session occurred a couple of months ago.
- 7. I was invited to present at a Councillor Information Session this month with representatives of the Sports Museum - I declined because this would be a repeat of a session already conducted.
- Community members have the right to express their views and be heard by Council, free from fear of repercussions.
- It is Council administration's role to provide technical and well-reasoned recommendations to Councillors who ultimately decide for the community by vote.
- 10. It is elected members (Councillors) role when voting on decisions that impact the whole community well beyond the election cycle that these decisions are based on sound reasoning, net cost benefits including social impact costs and with a strategic lens on what is best for our community over the forward years.
- 11. It is the Community's role to elect the members (Mayor and Councillors) to make these decisions for us.

Many residents I have spoken with are committed to building a united and thriving Allora, focussed on the liveability of our community and the wellbeing of our community members as demonstrated by the those attending Yoga in the Senior Citizens' Hall and the fantastic turn out for the Allora Bush Christmas party held on the weekend.

Can we please stop being divisive and tearing each other down. When this occurs, the only winners are Council because we are divided therefore no consensus, giving a free pass to Council to push their decisions down the road. Be united, find our common focus and be a united voice to Council. Let's get the Allora Community Hall open!

Merivale Street To Open Soon

Work is nearing an end at the Merivale Street crossing on the western side of Allora.

Wednesday, 13th December 2023

After being washed out by flooding the crossing will have a larger, more solid culvert.

A spokesperson for the Southern Downs Regional Council said the culvert is well advanced with final concrete works almost completed. In the next two weeks erosion protection works, road sealing and signs should be finished.

The increased size of culvert will provide increased flood immunity whilst concrete batter and erosion works will provide a more resilient structure for future flood events.



The culvert capacity has been increased from 1/375mm diameter concrete pipe to 3/1200x900mm concrete box culverts.

Weather permitting, works are expected to be completed and the road open by 22 December 2023.

Poet, Marco Gliori admits that standing behind a microphone, encouraging people to smile, steering proceedings, and sharing his community's stories become a huge part of his life. Some of the yarns he tells are inspired by local experiences, others by distant landscapes and characters he has met, whilst taking the road less travelled. Allora features in Marco's new book Poet on the Verandah, with poems such as 'Ode to Golfers' first recited at the Allora Golf Club at the opening of the Maher-Rickert Bridge, plus 'Ode

to Netballers' recited for Laura Geitz at the ceremony whereby she and Wayne Bennet were inducted to the Allora Sport's Museum's Hall of Fame, not to mention his poem 'Pride of Place' a poem recited by Marco on U-Tube featuring the creative talents of the Allora Photography Group, and 'The Melbourne Cup Came Waltzing' written for last year's Cup Visit.






