
Suddenly, the younger one began to do so in a very loud voice.

## Medical Centre Closer to Reality Southern Cross Care's General Manager of Legal Services

and Special Projects Paul Luton and Frank Bowling, Southern Cross Care's Treasurer of the Board of Management visited Allora on Tuesday, 6 December, attending the Homestead Aged Persons Hostel Christmas Afternoon Tea, and also taking part in an historical event regarding medical services for "the Best Little Town on the Downs".

Both members of the Southern Cross Care Board of Management carried out the official handover of the title deeds to the property at 45 Herbert Street, Allora to Allora Medical Support Group Chairman Jon Constable and committee member Roy Smith, in the presence of Allora Medical Practice staff Doctors Kaye Ellis and Leith Geisel, Practice Manager Sharon Caldwell and Practice Nurse Liz Henry. The address is the current site of the existing aging medical facility.

The presentation of the deeds is a significant landmark in the short history of the Allora Medical Support Group, a major step forward for the Group heading the thrust to have a new Medical Centre built in Allora's business centre. Mr. Constable thanked Southern Cross Care for their gesture of making their own land available to the AMSG in a tremendously generous act for a most minimal fee, for the development of a modern, efficient medical facility to service the Allora & district community's needs.


Southern Cross Care gained ownership of the Allora Medical Centre and other local interests including the Allora Nursing Home, Jubilee Gardens and the Homestead Aged Persons Hostel back on 16 September, 2003, and now has in effect gifted the Medical Centre property back to the Allora community. Mr. Luton was excited about the future for Allora's medical services, and the fact that Southern Cross Care had been able to play such a supportive role. "It's vital a rural centre and district such as Allora have a reliable well staffed medical centre to service the needs of its community" said Mr. Luton, "the idea to extend the current facility and add to services is a proactive move by the AMSG and will address community needs into the future, the upgrade of the centre also compliments Southern Cross Care interests in Allora".

An 18 month struggle and dedication to establish a new medical centre in Allora's town centre has now revealed the goals of the AMSG are indeed closing in on reality. Since its formation on 26 July 2010, the Allora Medical Support Group have maintained their focus on the establishment of a new Medical Facility within the Allora business centre, convenient and accessible to the local community and those further afield.

Thanks to the generosity and ongoing support of Southern Cross Care that focus has been strengthened, the Group is now engaged in the next step of the process about to lodge an application for funding through the National Rural and Remote Health Infrastructure Program, with assistance from the Southern Downs Regional Council.



Upcoming work in 2012 - Delays from recent wet weather mean the final pavement reconstruction at the sites West of Fig Tree Gully, Fig Tree Gully and Six Penny Gully will recommence on 9 January 2012. Changed traffic conditions, including single lane closures and stop/go traffic control will be in place at times for this work. These sites are expected to be complete by the

end of January 2012 (weather permitting). Work will also commence at the remaining site at Clayton's Gully, which was the most badly damaged. Work is due to start in February 2012 on a new stretch of road 600 metres long and four lanes wide.

Asphalt resurfacing - The final asphalt repairs and resurfacing through the Gap is also planned to start on 9 January 2012, weather permitting, following the busy holiday period. It will be carried out as day works under intermittent short-term stop/go traffic control and is planned to be complete in February 2012. 
