2010) -

During this period Allora police made 3 domestic violence applications and attended another 2 domestic disturbances that were classed as not domestic violence.

Officers conducted 203 breath tests resulting in 1 low range drink driver arrest and issued 36 infringement notices for offences including speeding (highest speed of 154 km/h in a 100 zone), hand held mobile phone, stop sign, driving with a recently expired driver's license, driving a defective motor vehicle, bicycle helmet, failing to transfer registration and unregistered trailers.

08/12/09: Unregistered and uninsured 25-year-old offender from Darling Heights was intercepted driving a Ford laser on the New England Hwy at Mt Marshall.

03/12/09 - 08/12/09: Theft of 320 litres of diesel fuel from a fuel tank on a rural property along Inverramsay Rd Goomburra. Matter unsolved.

12/12/09: Offender has broken and entered into business premises in the Industrial Estate Forest Springs Rd Allora. Premises entered were Evans Drilling, Superior Silage, Southern Downs Regional Council depot, Allora Joinery, Allora Engineering & Richard Kyle Landscaping. Minor damage was caused to premises. Offender was looking for cash kept on premises and nil else but a cheque was stolen. Matter unsolved & still under investigation.

25/01/10: 16-year-old Allora child was intercepted by police while he was driving a utility along the Warwick/Allora Road whilst unlicensed. He is to receive an official caution for the matter.

- 3. The notice published on 28 January 2010, having effect on the taking of water from the Upper Condamine and associated

- 7. The operation of this Notice is not affected by the making of submissions under clause 6 of this Notice.
- 8. A person must not take water in contravention of this notice. A contravention of this notice is an offence under section 25(4) of the Act and renders a person liable for a maximum penalty of 500 penalty units (\$37 500).

"Our various primary industries have had to adapt to a range of challenges including a 10 year drought, climate change, a high Aussie dollar, not to mention the havoc caused by feral animal pests such as wild dogs and flying foxes.'

Mr Randall said that while there have been challenges, there have also been many positive advances such as improvements in crop selection, animal genetics, irrigation techniques and improvements in the supply chain process.

"But there is one thing for sure, nothing stands still, and especially so for agriculture, so I strongly urge all those producers with an interest in future investment to attend the seminar," he said.

Industries which will feature at the seminar include beef, sheep and goats, wild game, feedlotting, poultry, grains, legumes, pulses, horticulture and wine.

The seminar which is being co-ordinated by the Department of Employment, Economic Development and Innovation will be held at the DEEDI Conference Centre, 203 Tor Street Toowoomba on Monday February 22 from 8.15am.
