Looking Back...

Sport in Allora

On 27th September 1909, a public meeting was called at the Oddfellow's Hall, for the formation of a swimming club in Allora. At that meeting the Allora Amateur Swimming Club was formed with Henry Ludgate as president. In November, tenders were called for the building of a safety cage and a dressing shed. At the Annual General Meeting held on the 16th January 1910, the club had 31 senior members and 24 junior members. They were all males as there wasn't dressing accommodation for females. The swimming baths in Dalrymple Creek were opened with a swimming carnival on the 23rd February 1910. It was stipulated that "universal costumes" be worn.

The Dianna Ladies Swimming Club was formed at a meeting held on 3rd October 1910. Swimming was still segregated, with males only taking part in the swimming carnival held on Boxing Day 1910. The main race was the 100 yard handicap for the Ludgate Cup.

The visit of Duke Kahanamouku for the New Year Carnival held on 13th January 1915 created huge interest in the district. The Hawaiian held the world record for 100 yards, and is credited for introducing the surf board to Australia. At the carnival Kahanamouku won the 400 yards handicap by a lap and a half, beating the second place getter who had

45 seconds start. The Ludgate Cup at the same carnival was won by Les Masters. It was in the possession of his family when he embarked for France later in the same year and with closure of the swimming club in the war years, was not competed for again. It was later donated to the Allora museum by the Masters' family.

In May 1923, the Allora Shire Council called a public meeting for the building of public baths in Allora. In spite of numerous enthusiastic public meetings, spirited fund raising, and the fact that Nobby already had a pool, the project came to nothing. In mid 1930 the Allora Shire Council constructed the weir at Roggenkamp's Crossing and the newly re-formed Allora Amateur Swimming Club held a meeting to arrange the cleaning out of the creek and the building of a diving facility.

1964 saw a renewed drive to build a swimming pool in Allora, and after much public fund raising, the Allora pool was built, and was officially opened in March 1966. Although a tennis court existed at East Talgai from the very early days, the Allora Lawn Tennis Club was formed at a public meeting held in the School of Arts on 18th April 1894. In the first inter-town match Allora defeated Clifton 20 games to 14 on the Recreation Ground court.

The Christian Endeavour Society opened a new court next the Wesleyan Church in Herbert Street in 1899 and

the Spring Creek Tennis Club was formed in May 1908. The opening of the newly formed Shamrock Tennis Club's court in September 1911 was the first mention of an ant bed court in Allora. Courts were opened at Deuchar and Hendon in 1912 and at Goomburra in 1913.

Post war saw a profusion of tennis clubs and courts spring up throughout the district.

The Allora Tennis Association was formed at a meeting held in June 1926 between representatives of the Allora, Barnes & Co., Deuchar, Hendon, Headington Hill, Plain View (McMillan's), Old Goomburra, and Berat Tennis Clubs. Later in the same year they were joined by the Goomburra Town and Inveramsay Clubs.

By the 1930's the association included Plainview, Spring Creek, Riversleigh (Muir's), Centrals, Berat, Wattles (Anderson's), Diggers, Ellinthorp, Dougall's, Berat, Talgai West, Goomburra Town, Victoria Hill, Hendon, Mount Marshall and Forest Springs Clubs.

A district tournament, played over six week ends, was held in 1934 with over 180 entries. Keith Wright from Goomburra was the men's singles champion and Miss D. McMillan was the ladies champion.

- The notice published on 26 March 2010, having effect on the taking of water from the Upper Condamine and associated tributaries is withdrawn.

 - water allocations for any purpose that have both a nil passing flow condition and a condition stating that the water cannot be stored, and
 - water licences for irrigation purposes, is limited as follows until further notice.

- 8.** A person must not take water in contravention of this notice. A contravention of this notice is an offence under section 25(4) of the Act and renders a person liable for a maximum penalty of 500 penalty units (\$50 000).
