### One month remaining to lodge tax returns

View the "Tax time 2011 - one month to lodge" ATO YouTube video here.

The ATO is reminding the community they have until 31 October to lodge their tax returns if they are not using a registered tax agent.

Tax Commissioner Michael D'Ascenzo said one of the easiest and quickest ways to lodge your tax return is by using e-tax.

"E-tax is available to download free of charge from our website at [www.ato.gov.au/etax](http://www.ato.gov.au/etax) and so far this year almost 1.9 million people have taken advantage of this easy lodgement option.

"E-tax can save you time by downloading information from third parties directly into your tax return. This includes information such as bank interest, payment summaries, government payments, parental leave payments and information to assist in determining eligibility for the education tax refund."

The ATO also runs a free Tax Help program which assists low income earners with simple tax affairs to prepare and lodge their tax returns. Tax Help is run by ATO trained community volunteers and is available in all capital cities and many regional areas across Australia. For information on how to make an appointment at your nearest Tax Help centre call the ATO on 13 28 61.

#### TAX TIME TIPS - Avoid common mistakes.

To help you prepare your tax return correctly and ensure it is processed as quickly as possible, make sure you include:

- your correct date of birth
- current address
- all your income such as interest from bank accounts, a previous job and income from overseas
- distributions from sources such as trusts, investments, and capital gains, and
- details relating to the Medicare levy or Medicare levy surcharge.

#### Be aware of tax scams

During tax time it is important to be aware of tax scams. A variety of scams may be used to try to trick individuals into providing their personal details and pay money. Scammers use phone calls, letters, text messages, emails, bogus websites and even false job advertisements.

If you are approached in one of these ways be cautious and do not provide any personal or financial details. The ATO will never ask you to pay money to receive your tax refund or any special government payment.

If you think you have been the victim of a scam, contact the ATO client contact centre immediately by phoning 13 28 61 (8.00am to 6.00pm, Monday to Friday) who will be able to assist.

#### Claim only what you are entitled to

It is important that you only claim what you are entitled to, and keep records to support the claims you make. Generally, these should be kept for five years.

Since the beginning of July, the ATO has stopped for review around 68,000 suspicious returns worth more than \$285 million that we believe include potentially overstated or fraudulent refund claims, including claims for spouse offset, education tax refunds and refund of franking credits. These taxpayers will need to provide documentation in order to substantiate their claims. The number of returns stopped has increased from this time last year, largely as a result of the enhanced sophistication of our systems to

#### Allora Pony Club Anniversary

The Allora Pony Club celebrated its 21st anniversary on Friday night the 10th October, 1986, with a Charity Birthday Ball and on Saturday the 11th October, 1986, with a reunion of past members and friends at the Allora Showgrounds.

The club was formed at a meeting convened by Stuart Henry, Chairman of the Allora Shire Council, at the Council Office on the 23rd September 1965, and attended by Andy Haig, Stuart Henry, George Anderson, Alec Hoey, Len Batterham and the Rev. Father Thomas McCormack. Alan Gilmore, a representative of the Clifton Pony Club, also attended by invitation. The foundation office bearers were: George Anderson (patron), Stuart Henry (president), Andy Haig (secretary/treasurer). A muster of children and ponies was held at the Allora Showgrounds on Sunday, 10th October, 1965. Ken Telford was the club's first qualified instructor.

The club went from strength to strength, with 20 junior members in 1966 increasing to 40 in 1978. Len Batterham was the Chief Instructor for the ten years from 1967 to 1976. During that time the club had great success at a zone level and at the R. N. A and Toowoomba Royal Shows. Noel and Glen Holmes represented their State at the N. S. W. pony club's championships.

#### Goomburra Railway

After some six years of agitation, deputations to Ministers, entertainment of Parliamentary parties etc., the settlers of the Goomburra valley had the pleasure of witnessing the turning of the first sod of their railway by the Premier of Queensland, the Hon D. F. Denham, on Monday last. The Premier, the Minister of Railways, and a large Parliamentary party arrived in Allora by a special train on the previous evening. They were met at the station by the Allora to Goomburra Railway Extension Committee and escorted to the Commercial Hotel where they spent the night. The next day, on the invitation of the Mayor (Ald. Charles Bourne), the Premier, after doffing his coat, turning up his sleeves and putting on the orthodox bowyangs, cut out a neat sod which he shovelled into a barrow, wheeled along a plank and tipped out in a business-like manner, amidst cheers. "We are on the way to Goomburra now" he said, to the accompaniment of renewed cheers.

**Seniors urged to be scam savvy**  
The Queensland Office of Fair Trading is reminding seniors to be wary of random phone calls, emails or letters they may receive requesting money or personal details as many of these are simply a scam.  
The advice comes as Queensland celebrates International Day of Older Persons.  
Office of Fair Trading Executive Director Brian Bauer said while International Day of Older Persons recognizes the important contribution seniors make, it also serves as a good opportunity to examine those issues that affect this group in the community.  
"From a consumer protection perspective, one issue that seems to be relevant to seniors is the prevalence of scams targeted towards them," Mr Bauer said.  
"Sadly seniors are commonly the unsuspecting victims of common scams like the Nigerian money scam, inheritance scams and fake overseas lotteries.  
"Therefore it is timely to remind seniors to be wary of these types of scams which operate on the basis of appearing to be legitimate request but in reality is just a ploy to gain access to your hard earned savings or to obtain your identity to be used for fraudulent purposes."  
Mr Bauer said the well-known computer virus con seems to be the scam of the moment with the Office of Fair Trading receiving many reports over the past few months.  
"In this scam, consumers receive a cold call from a person purporting to be from a reputable computer company," Mr Bauer said.  
"The caller advises the person that they have a record showing their computer has been infected with a virus and by allowing remote access to their computer the company can run a scan to identify the virus.  
"Usually a fake scan is done on the computer with the caller informing the consumer the scan has indeed confirmed a virus however by purchasing a virus protection program over the phone they can install software to eradicate the virus.  
"The caller requests bank details to purchase the software but

sadly the only thing that is removed is funds from the consumer's bank account. In some cases a person's identity can also be stolen from this type of scam."  
Mr Bauer said many seniors may fall victim to this type of scam. "If you receive a call from a person saying your computer has a virus our advice is simply hang up.  
These callers are usually based overseas and are banking on you believing their fabricated story is the truth and in order to protect yourself you must give them access to your computer and buy their computer software," Mr Bauer said.  
"If you have some concerns about the security of your computer take your machine to a reputable computer service centre or arrange for them to visit you in person at your home. Better still ask a family member or trusted friend who may have some knowledge of computer security to install authentic virus and spyware protection.  
"Always be wary of any person who contacts you out of the blue whether it is via email, phone or letter requesting an upfront payment or personal details.  
"There is a very good chance their intentions are not as honourable as you may think."
